

# Do you teach Arabic to Arabic speakers or Chinese to Chinese speakers?

**Would you like to know the key techniques that help students learn faster, remember more, and enjoy their classes?**

**Would you like to be a more confident teacher and learn how to plan and create successful lessons for students of all levels of ability?**

This 20-hour short course will give you practical experience of the keys to successful teaching. No previous experience of teaching is necessary, but is an advantage. Most of the course will take place in English, so you should be comfortable in an English-speaking environment and be able to participate actively in class. There is no assessment of English level.

The course is an introduction to the basic principles of successful language teaching. We will look at techniques you can use to plan and conduct lessons that help learners become more fluent speakers of Arabic or Chinese.

We will follow a communicative approach that helps you create and adapt stimulating materials. You will learn about classroom management, and key techniques for teaching the four skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening. You'll also learn how to teach aspects of grammar and vocabulary, and will become familiar with a range of different activity types to use in lessons.
