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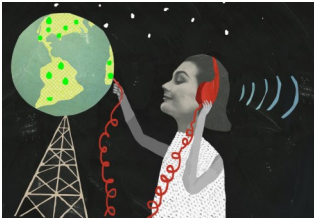


Summer Holiday Language Immersion Challenge

- This programme is open to Year 10 students who will take their GCSEs next year.
- Participants will be awarded **Gold**, **Silver** or **Bronze** certificates after the summer holidays.
 - **Bronze Certificate = 4 challenges completed**
 - **Silver Certificate = 8 challenges completed**
 - **Gold Certificate = 12 or more challenges completed**

- Booklets must be returned to your MFL teacher in September. Following this, certificates will be awarded.

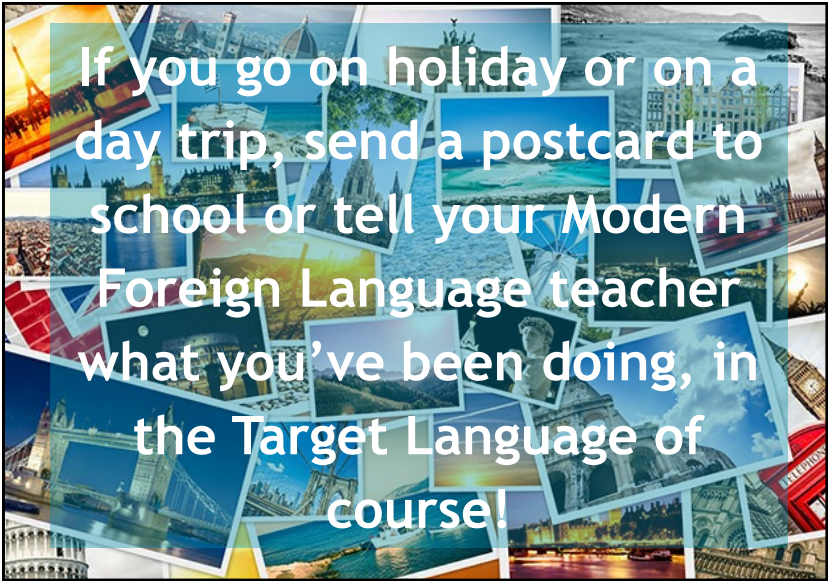
