A language intervention programme.





What is Double Club?

A totally unique approach to developing in your pupils both an enthusiasm for speaking languages and a basic grounding in the language.

Using the excitement of Premier League football, NCFC Languages Double Club delivers a weekly dose of language support in your school!

The course has been produced in 6 Units which build towards making your students confident Level 3 learners, capable of holding a basic conversation and asking/ answering questions in Spanish.

What can I expect from Double Club?

- An exciting, topical scheme of work produced by a qualified teacher, based on football and recent Norwich matches. Activities are fun and competitive and concentrate on developing an interest in speaking and studying foreign languages.
- An NCFC Language Champion visits your school once a week and works alongside a member of staff in your school to deliver 90 minutes of language fun.
- A Teacher's pack and a Spanish Double Club workbook for each pupil.
- An NCFC Language Champion who will attend each session, and will run the weekly football coaching session based on supporting language development.
- A Language day for you and your pupils at Carrow Road.
- A half-day training event, held at Carrow Road, which will train your Double Club staff member on how to use the materials and provide practical suggestions on how to use football as a basis for language development.
- A Routes into Languages East certificate for each pupil who successfully completes the course.

Does it really make pupils more enthusiastic about languages?

A pilot at City Academy in Norwich was used to launch Spanish to year 8 pupils. At the end of the pilot 71% said they enjoyed learning languages, and 64% said it had made them keen to continue learning Spanish.

How much does it cost?

For a limited time only the whole course - Teacher's pack, all resources, Staff training session, Language Champion and Carrow Road Spanish Day - will cost £780 for up to 20 students. This is an introductory offer and will only be available to schools until Friday 28th September 2012.
