How has studying languages affected your career choice?

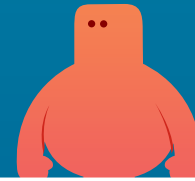
I have been able to work abroad with both children and adults and plan to in the future. As of September I will be a teacher of business English in Grenoble, France.
