# Language Presenter of the Year Competition 2013/14

OCR and Routes into Languages East are working together to reward our young people's language learning.

<u>The competition is in two parts:</u> the first part is to design a poster for the Language Presenter of the Year Competition 2013/4. The second part is the Language Presenter of the Year Competition itself, which will be launched in September, using the winning poster from part 1

## Part 1 (open to Y7 and above)

- a competition to design a poster
- Prize for the best poster is £30 vouchers (2 runners up will receive vouchers worth £20 each)

Students are asked to design a poster to advertise the competition to find our "Language Presenter of the Year".

The poster is A4 size, colour, with images that can be reproduced (i.e. with copyright permission). The poster needs to be available in word and PDF. It somehow needs to illustrate/suggest the importance of languages and communicating in a multilingual world where not everyone speaks English!

## What needs to be included in the poster?

Pupils need to include in their poster **details** of the competition for "Language Presenter of the Year" for GCSE Y10 and Y11 students. They are asked to present a product either of their own design or a creative presentation of an existing product in 3 – 5 minutes. They can use a power point to help to showcase their design with details of the product/its cost/colour schemes/availability on the high street or internet, and each entry must be an individual one (no group entries). All entries for this part of the competition must be submitted as a sound file clearly marked with the student's name and school by Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February 2014. Reminders will be sent out nearer the time.

## **Entry deadline for posters**

Poster entries must be emailed to Sarah Schechter at Routes into Languages East: <a href="mailto:routes@anglia.ac.uk">routes@anglia.ac.uk</a> by 19<sup>th</sup> July 2013 (no entries will be accepted after this date). Posters will be judged by a panel and their decision will be final. The winning design will be used to promote the Language Presenter of the Year Competition for 2014. Winners will be notified by the beginning of September 2013.
